CONSERVATIVE GOVERNMENT FUNDING NEW HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTRE



Highlights of the project:

- The first phase will provide space for an additional 1,800 full-time students (completion of the second phase will bring the total capacity to 3,000 students)
- The Centre will provide 400 new full and part-time jobs for staff and faculty, bringing an increase to the Georgian payroll of \$16 million.
- The Centre will include community-accessible teaching health care clinics where members of the public, including students, can access health care. At the same time, Health Sciences students will gain valuable clinical experience.

\$20 million investment from the Federal Government
(Scheduled to be fully operational for students by September 2011)
